Thanks to U.S. government programs and interventions:

- » Since 1990, the number of mothers dying from pregnancy and childbirth complications has decreased by 44%.
- » 6.8 million more children under 5 survived in 2015 than in 1990.
- » In 2015 alone, 267,000 babies were born HIV-free.
